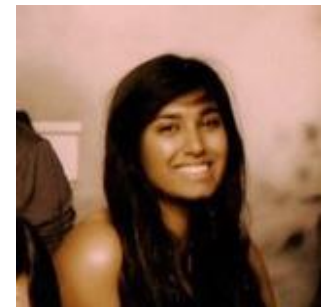
Treasurer: Margaret Hong

1) District Points

- a) Meetings
 - i) Each member attending receives **one** point for his or her club
- b) Projects/Socials
 - i) Each member attending receives **two** points for his or her club
- c) Newsletter Contest Winner
 - i) One winner receives **three** points for his/her club

2) Individual Club Points

- a) **One** point per service hour
- b) **One** point per event
- c) Appearance on Media
 - i) **One** point per appearance
 - ii) Must have proof of newspaper clipping, etc.

3) Awards

- a) **Club of the Year**
 - i) Small—1-30 members
 - ii) Medium—31-60 members
 - iii) Large—61+ members
- b) **Leo of the Year**
 - i) District advisors will consider
 - (1) Demonstration of Leadership and Leoism
 - (2) Club Advisor recommendations/nominations
 - (3) Individual Points (total service hours + district points)
